
TUITION CENTRES


Tuition centres have been established in villages where the tutor is selected from the village itself and he/she is responsible for teaching the children and spreading awareness.



ABOUT US

Founded in 1996, Don Bosco Child Labour Mission (DBCLM), Davangare is an organisation of the Salesians of Don Bosco, directed towards serving the Young at Risk: the Child Labourers. DBCLM gets its inspiration from Don Bosco (the Educator-priest of the 19th century who was actively involved in helping the poor and abandoned youth).

VISION

The main aim is to restore the lost childhood of the child labourers and set them free from the shackles of labour by educating and rehabilitating them.



MISSION

Trying to bring back every child labourer to school in Davangare district by preventing child labour and by creating sustainable community structures like Child Rights Clubs. Child Labour Prevention and Child Rights Protection Committees are also part of the measures to help the children.



ACHIEVEMENTS

The project attempts to identify and support child labourers, school dropouts, single parents and orphan children by counseling them and their parents, and admitting them to school or the Residential Bridge Course (operated by Don Bosco). The target groups are the working children in various sectors like garages, hotels, petty shops, industrial sites, agricultural labourers and bonded child labourers. These children are either school dropouts or do not get the chance to go to school. From 2012-2017, around 500 children have been rescued and enrolled into bridge schools. After their bridge course, most of them have continued to study further in fields of Nursing, Polytech, Commerce, Humanities and Social Sciences. Out of the rescued children, around 360 are employed in different areas. There are quite a few stories of accomplishment!
